

Application Guideline For International Students (For Freshman and Transfer Students)

I. General

1. Admission Policy

Wakkanai Hokusei Gakuen University invites applications from competent candidates who are willing to gain advanced knowledge in Information Technology after getting acquainted with Japanese culture and developing Japanese language proficiency.

3. Application Eligibility

Applicants must fulfill any one of the following requirements:

Freshman Admission Requirements (Program available only at Wakkanai main campus)

1. Applicants must either have completed 12-years of school education by the time of application OR has completed the equivalent of 12 years of school education as approved by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology;
2. Have the ABITUR recognized as a qualification for enrolling in universities in Japan by the Ministry of Education, Sports and Technology (Monkasho) of Japan.
3. Be at least 18 years of age by the time of application and the scholastic attainment of the applicant

meets the University entrance requirement or above.

Transfer Students-Admission Requirements (From Second Year)

Note: To be eligible for transfer program as second year student, students must meet the freshman requirements of above and also meet any of the terms mentioned below:

Candidate who has graduated from junior college or expected to graduate by March 2010.

Candidate who has graduated from vocational/technical school or expected to graduate by March 2010.

Candidate who has been studying in University for more than 1 year and has obtained at least 30 credits or expected to obtain such credits by March 2010.

Candidate who has graduated from College/University or expected to graduate by March 2010.

Candidate who has graduated from Special Training College or is expected to graduate by March 2010.

Transfer Students-Admission Requirements (From Third Year)

Note: To be eligible for transfer program as third year student, students must meet the freshman requirements of above and also any of the terms mentioned below:

Candidate who has graduated from junior college or expected to graduate by March 2010.

Candidate who has graduated from vocational/technical school or expected to graduate by March 2010.

Candidate who has been studying in University for more than 1 year and has obtained at least 30 credits or expected to obtain such credits by March 2010.

Candidate who has graduated from College/University or expected to graduate by March 2010.

Candidate who has graduated from Special Training College or is expected to graduate by March 2010.

(The study period must be two years or more, and the total class time must be 1700 hours or more.)

Note: To be eligible for the visa issuance for Japan, candidates are required to have the Japanese Language proficiency of Level 2 or higher.

4. Guarantor and Financial Sponsor

Both the Japanese residents and foreign citizens are eligible to be the Guarantor/Sponsor of the

candidate.

The guarantor owes responsibility concerning all conduct of the candidate during his/her study period. Also, the guarantor/sponsor owes the responsibility for all the expenses of the candidate. In addition, the guarantor/sponsor is required to guide the candidate in order to obey the law of Japan and the regulations of Wakkanai Hokusei Gakuen University and to not get involved in the activity other than the study purpose.

B. In case of remitting from outside Japan

8. Cautionary Notes

If the documents are in languages other than English or Japanese, please also submit an authorized translation of the same.

All certificates must be original or attested by authorized person. The copies are not accepted.

The applicants from China are required to submit the documents in the form of notarization book.

Application will be rejected if any discrepancy or incompleteness is found in the documents.

If any false information is found in the documents even after the success in the result of the candidate, it will lead to the rejection of the entrance procedure.

If any false information is found in the documents even after the candidate's successful admission, it will lead to his/her immediate dismissal.

9. Application Materials

Applicants themselves must fill out the application form accurately.

9.3. Health Certificate (Prescribed form provided by our University)

The form must be filled out by a doctor. The X-ray test of your chest must be taken within 6 months.

9.4. Certificate of Kinship (Family registration book)

Please submit the proof of identity such as citizenship certificate or the copy of family registration book.

Please submit the original or Certified True Copy of the document.

All certificates should be written either in Japanese or in English. Certificates with languages other than the above mentioned must be attached with the translation in English or Japanese (Translation from the applicant's school is preferable).

When the certificate is not issued in English or in Japanese both from the graduate school and the government of home country, please prepare the translation by yourself and attach with the statements from the embassy or competent agency at your home country stating that the translation is correct.

9.5. Certificate of graduation/Academic records or transcripts—Applicants from China must submit with notarization book.

Please submit as per the following instruction. Certificates must be either original or certified true copy.

When the final academic background is a Senior High school

(Applicant who is not graduated from high school at the time of application)

Expected certificate of Graduation.

Note: High school graduation is the condition for admission, so you must show the graduation certificate by the date of entrance ceremony.

Applicant who has taken the Japanese language Proficiency test level 2 or above are required to submit the copy of the score and admission card of the examination. Applicant who has taken Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) are required to submit the copy of score report and also the copy of admission card.

9.7. Proposed Plan of Study (Prescribed form provided by our University)

This document must be written in Japanese by the applicant him/herself.

9.8. Financial Support Documents

If the sponsor is from the applicant's home country

Please provide all the credentials mentioned below in **No** , **and** in the name of Sponsor.

Bank Balance Certificate (Certificate from a reliable bank that can remit the foreign currency)

If the applicant is scheduled to return his/her home country after completing the study in our University, the required balance is total tuition fees of the candidate and the expenses for his/her living (Approx. 100,000 JPY per month). If the candidate is planning to join Master's degree, the balance certificate should cover the total expenses of his/her study at our University plus the cost of his/her study after the graduation.

Employment Certificate: Applicants from China should append the notarization certificate (This certificate must indicate the income of past 3 years)

The employment certificate should include the Candidate's total income during his/her employment period. If the sponsor is the owner of the company, please provide the corporate profile along with company's registration certificate

Certificate of tax payment. Applicants from China should append the notarization certificate (of past three years)

Please submit the certificate of tax payment history of the sponsor.

Sponsor Letter (Prescribed form provided by our University)

Please write in detail on how you will cover the expenditures of the candidate. Please also provide the reason of your support.

Certificate of kinship (Family registration book)

Please submit the certificate of kinship by which the identification of the sponsor can be perceived.

In the case of self-funding

Bank balance certificate (Certificate from a reliable bank that can remit foreign currencies). Please submit the original certificates.

If the applicant is scheduled to return to his/her home country after completing the study in our University, the required balance is total tuition fees of the candidate and his/her living expenses (Approx. 100,000JPY per month). If the candidate is planning to join Master's Program, the balance certificate should cover the total expenses of his/her study at our University plus the cost of his/her study after the graduation.

Employment Certificate: (Applicants from China should append the notarization certificate indicating the income of past 3 years)

The employment certificate should include the total income during his/her employment. If the sponsor is the owner of the company, please provide the corporate profile along with company registration certificate

9. 12. Representative Request Form for the “Certificate of Eligibility” (Only those who wish to request University to act as his/her representative)

You may request our University to act as your representative for the submission of Application in the Immigration Bureau of Japan. Please read the explanation given at section II below under the title of “Applying for certificate of eligibility”.

10. Selection procedure and result announcement**10.1. Method of Selection**

Selection will be done on the basis of submitted documents. However, University may request

to undergo with the following procedures and evaluate on the basis of overall screening.

10.1.1. Interview and Examination of applicants

For those who are residing in Japan: We will inquire through telephone regarding the Japanese Language proficiency.

Note: Applicants may be asked to come to the University as per required.

For those who are not in Japan: Confirmation of the Japanese language proficiency of the applicant will be made through telephonic conversation.

10.1.2 Interview with guarantor/financial sponsor

For those who are residing in Japan: We will inquire through telephone regarding the will/reason of sponsorship and the expenditure of the applicant during his/her study.

Note: Guarantors/Financial sponsors may be asked to come to the University as per required. Sponsors/Guarantors are therefore required to report the University for the interview. (If the applicant and financial sponsor and the guarantor are residing in Japan, University may request both the applicant and his/her sponsor/guarantor to come for the interview together)

11. Admission Procedure and Tuition fees

For the successful applicants, we will send the notification of acceptance along with documents of admission and its procedure. Please complete the application for admission by the stipulated deadline.

11.1. Tuition fees

Please remit the tuition fee at the time of your admission process. For the details of the tuition fees, please refer the tables at the end of the section of this guideline.

Notes:

1. We have the provision of tuition fee waiver for the students and those who seek such offer are required to apply to the university..

2. While remitting to the University account directly from overseas' financial institutions, a tuition fees plus the handling commission of Mizuho Bank Ltd. Japan (For the details of handling charge, please confirm at your bank) should be remitted by the specified deadline to which the transferred amount must be confirmed.

3. Furthermore, the remitting bank (such as Bank of America etc) might levy an extra commission at your side. In such case, please bear the extra charge also. The handling commission may vary from bank to bank; so please confirm during remitting, however, normally it will be around 20-30 US dollars. If there is the lack in the payment, a necessary procedure to acquire certificate of eligibility will not be done.

4. Please keep the remittance receipt safe. In the case of admission refusal, this receipt will be required at the time of refunding the tuition fees.

12. Declining Admission

If your application for a Certificate of Eligibility is not successful or if you decide to enter another University even after the completion of admission procedure, please submit your notification to us by the dates specified below. Your Tuition Fees, except the application fee, will be refunded to you.

For 2010 April entrance: 19th March, 2010.

As enough time is required for the procedure please apply well in advance. For the applicants who wish to decline the admission, we will send necessary document and procedure for the entrance refusal and the tuition fee refund.

II. Applying for “Certificate of Eligibility” (Please read carefully before applying)

In order to receive a 'College Student' resident status and reside in Japan, you must obtain the “Certificate of Eligibility” which can be submitted after receiving the “Certificate of Acceptance”

A. If the applicant is currently residing in Japan

For Applicant holding a 'Pre-college Student' visa, please apply for a 'Change of Residence Status' at the Immigration Office.

If you are a spouse of a Japanese national or permanent resident of Japan, etc., there is no requirement to change the visa status. However, in these cases applicant may not receive certain privileges that are given to those on a "College Student" visa.

For any other status than the above mentioned, please consult with the immigration office.

B. If the applicant is residing outside Japan

Application to obtain the Certificate of Eligibility will be submitted to the immigration bureau Japan after receiving the enrollment certificate of the University. Please apply to the embassy at your home country for visa processing with this eligibility certificate along with the enrollment certificate and other necessary documents. Please follow the instructions below.

Application for Certificate of Eligibility

After receiving the Enrollment Certificate, application for this certificate will be processed. This application can be submitted by the applicants themselves or by the representative. If the applicants can not submit on their own please follow the instructions below whereby the representative of the applicant can apply on behalf of the applicant.

Representative Application by Wakkanai Hokusei Gakuen University

Qualification to act as representative

International students desiring to enter our University can request University to act as their representative for the submission of application if any of the following conditions is fulfilled.

1. Those who have sufficient fund to pay for all expenses during their period of study and explained such detail in the prescribed form provided by University
2. Those who have received a scholarship which support the entire expenses during their period of study.

Request procedure to be representative

Submit the prescribed form of “Representative Application” if you wish our University to act as your representative. However, our University has authority to decide whether to act on your behalf. In case of rejection, either for Certificate of Eligibility or for the reason of denial to act as representative, no objections from the applicants will be accepted.

Steps of applying to be representative

1. Please apply for admission as instructed in the notification of result
2. After completing admission procedure, representative application will be made
3. If the certificate of eligibility is issued from the immigration, certificate of enrollment will be sent to the applicants. For unsuccessful applicants only the result will be sent.

Inquiries about the necessary documents and procedure should be made to the Immigration Office.
